

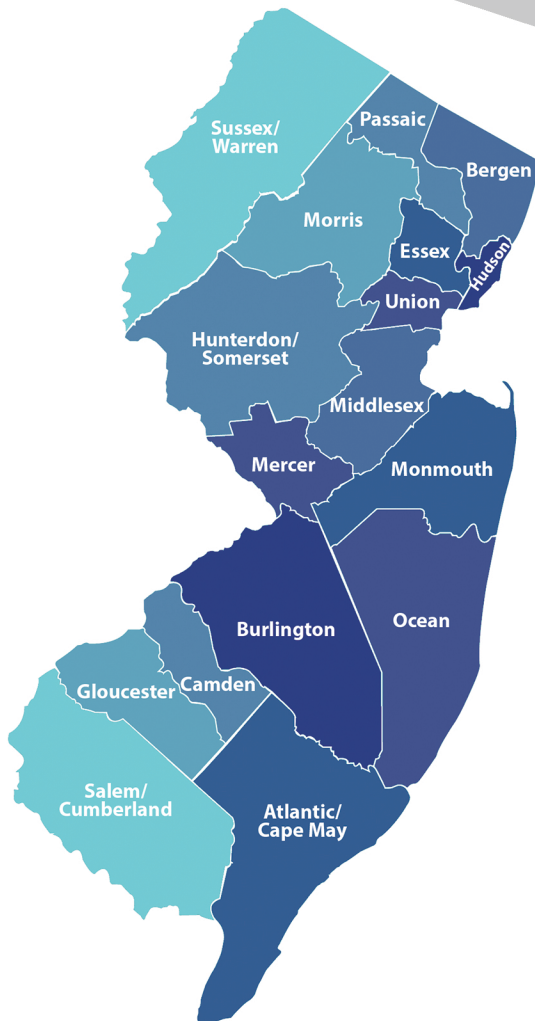
# NEW JERSEY REGIONAL COALITIONS
